About 1933 I was thrilled with a call to serve on a ward genealogy committee & later [...] as B of R chairman

In the C.H ward when I met my future husband Ells he was with a group of Elders with other EI who hadn't yet had dance for a mission were encouraged to start my temple attendance.

Immediately occurred to me there was good reason that so many members lacked interest in this imp. labor because it wasn't talked about enough or kept in their mind

A year or so later when he left for a short term mission I decided to do get a rec to help me pass the time more usefully during his absence. My young cousin Winnie S. was already [...]
